

Stepping Flexures

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DESCRIPTION

This technology is an actuator. The actuator has a pair of elements joined together by a flexure. The elements and the flexure are located between surfaces of a frame with a race formed between surfaces. One of the elements is joined to the load. A moving unit selectively attracts or repels corresponding element towards or away from the surface of the frame. The load is moved towards or away from the elements by changing the position of one of the elements on the surfaces of the frame.
